
Water Saving

- Users (Occupants + Visitors) increased 30-100% compared to 2009 baseline
- Total reduced water consumption = 1,354,764 tons (From 2007 to 2018)
- Strategy: Installing water saving fixtures / rainwater harvesting system



Energy Saving

- Save 405 Million kWh from 2007 to 2018 although occupancy rate increased
- Total reduced carbon emission 188,240 tons =556 Forest Parks


